

2 Kings — Worksheet 2: Answer Key

Naaman Healed — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

1. Who was Naaman, and what condition did he have (summarise from 2 Kings 5:1)?

A commander of the Syrian army, and a leper.

2. What instruction did Elisha send to Naaman through a messenger (2 Kings 5:10)?

To wash in the Jordan River seven times.

3. How did Naaman initially react to this instruction (2 Kings 5:11-12)?

He was angry, expecting something more dramatic, and pointed out that rivers in his own country were better than the Jordan.

4. What convinced Naaman to actually obey (2 Kings 5:13)?

His servants pointed out that if Elisha had asked something difficult, he would gladly have done it — so why not this simple thing?

5. What happened once Naaman washed in the Jordan seven times (2 Kings 5:14)?

His flesh was restored, clean like a little child's.

6. Reflection: Naaman almost missed his healing because the instruction seemed too simple. Is there a simple step of obedience you've been overlooking?
