### 2. What behaviour does Paul criticise in 2 Thessalonians 3:11?

Those living disorderly, not working at all, but being busybodies (interfering in others' business).

### 3. What instruction is given instead, in 2 Thessalonians 3:12?

To work quietly and eat their own bread.

### 4. What encouragement is given in 2 Thessalonians 3:13?

'Be not weary in well doing.'

### 5. Reflection: What does this passage suggest about the connection between faith and ordinary, practical responsibility?
