

# Luke — Worksheet 1: Answer Key

The Birth of Jesus & His Early Ministry — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

## 1. Who visited Mary to tell her she would give birth to Jesus, and how did she respond (Luke 1:26-38)?

The angel Gabriel; Mary responded, 'Be it unto me according to thy word,' accepting the news despite her questions.

## 2. What did the angels announce to the shepherds, and where did they find the baby Jesus (Luke 2:8-16)?

'Good tidings of great joy' that a Saviour, Christ the Lord, was born; they found Him lying in a manger.

## 3. What did Jesus read from the scroll of Isaiah in the synagogue at Nazareth, and what did He say about it afterward (Luke 4:16-21)?

A passage about the Spirit of the Lord anointing Him to preach good news, freedom, and healing; He said the scripture was fulfilled that day in their hearing.

## 4. Reflection: What do you think it means that God chose to reveal Jesus' birth first to lowly shepherds rather than to important people?

Open reflection — look for engagement with themes of humility and God's concern for the overlooked.
