# Scripture for Joshua — The Fall of Jericho & Choosing to Serve the Lord

King James Version. Flip back to the front to answer the questions.

## Joshua 6:1-5

<sup>1</sup>Now Jericho was straitly shut up because of the children of Israel: none went out, and none came in.

<sup>2</sup>And the LORD said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand Jericho, and the king thereof, and the mighty men of valour. <sup>3</sup>And ye shall compass the city, all ye men of war, and go round about the city once.

Thus shalt thou do six days. <sup>4</sup>And seven priests shall bear before the ark seven trumpets of rams' horns: and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, and the priests shall blow with the trumpets.

<sup>5</sup>And it shall come to pass, that when they make a long blast with the ram's horn, and when ye hear the sound of the trumpet, all the people shall shout with a great shout; and the wall of the city shall fall down flat, and the people shall ascend up every man straight before him.

## Joshua 6:20

<sup>20</sup>So the people shouted when the priests blew with the trumpets: and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.

## Joshua 24:14-15

<sup>14</sup>Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD. <sup>15</sup>And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
